



RE: Ohio Neighbor to Neighbor Program, American Electric Power (AEP)

Starting December 1, 2019, Ohio Heartland Community Action Commission will begin accepting applications for the AEP, Neighbor to Neighbor Program.

These funds are limited and are available on a first come first served basis. Applicants must be a customer of American Electric Power (AEP). Only applications with all required documentation will be accepted. They will be date stamped and processed in the order they were received.

Applicants can be seen in any one of our 3 locations Monday through Friday by appointment. Call 740-383-2154 for Marion County, 419-468-5121 for Crawford County, and 419-946-2009 for Morrow County. Residents of other counties, please call the center in the closest county to you.

General Guidelines

Individuals, couples and families are all eligible to apply . No specific county of residence requirement.

The income ceiling for this program is 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). (200 % chart below)

The maximum amount available toward past due balance is \$200. Must have an outstanding balance on their AEP Ohio bill of at least \$50.

The Ohio Neighbor to Neighbor Program can be awarded one grant per program year during either the heating or cooling program periods.

Verifications needed with the application

- 1. Proof of ID for the applicant: (Applicant should be the AEP account holder or Rate Payer)
- Drivers License, Photo ID Card, Passport
- Proof of social security numbers for ALL household members
2. Proof of income for everyone in the home:
- Past 4 weeks of current pays, unemployment, child support, social security, and any other income. If no income, an affidavit must be completed (we will provide the affidavit).
3. American Electric Power (AEP) electric bill:
- Termination Notice or most recent bill (must show past-due balance).
4. Applicants must have paid at least \$75 on their AEP account in the 3 months prior to applying for the grant.
5. Verification the applicant has applied for HEAP/EHEAP (when applicable). Do not let this requirement stop you from applying.
