

Electric Partnership Program (EPP)

The Electric Partnership Program (EPP), helps eligible Ohioans reduce their electricity usage in their home. We provide in-home audits and install appropriate electric energy efficiency measures to reduce electric usage; which may include replacement of refrigerators and freezers. Customers also receive information on how they can reduce their electric use and improve their home's efficiency.

Who is Eligible for EPP?

Customers living in Morrow, Allen, Hancock, Hardin, Putnam and Wyandot Counties are eligible for EPP if they are on or eligible for the Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP), having a total household income that is at or below [150%](#) of the federal poverty guidelines.

To be eligible for the program, customer must also have 12 months of electric usage at their current address, have an annual electric baseload usage of at least 5,000 kWh, and live in the service territory of American Electric Power or FirstEnergy (Ohio Edison).

*Customers may only receive this service once per address. This is an appliance replacement program.
